



Discover Oregon Non-Exclusive Royalty-Free Public Display License of Edited Films for Offices, Small Businesses, Waiting Rooms, Schools, and Other Organizations

This License is only valid with an accompanying purchase receipt.

A. Your Rights. We, Discover Oregon Video Productions, LLC the owner of discoveroregon.org, grant you or the organization you represent a perpetual right to display the edited films you purchase and obtain from us at your small office, business, waiting room, lobby, or other place of work provided the requirements of this document are met. The record of the specific License level you have purchased – Basic, Extended, or Premium – is specifically listed in your purchase receipt as well as the titles of the films you have purchased. This License is non-exclusive and only becomes valid with your accompanying record of purchase receipt. This Public Display License is not valid for broadcast, re-uploading of files to the internet, or re-using portions of this content in other independent media works in any way. It is only for display of complete edited films in your physical place of business.

B. Our Guarantee. We promise that if you use our Edited Films as described in this License, your use will not infringe on the rights of a third party as all Edited Films were created by Tyler Hulett and Discover Oregon, LLC – and only includes only fully Licensed content and content independently owned and created by Tyler Hulett and Discover Oregon.

C. Limitations.

1. You cannot sell, sub-license, or redistribute our Edited Films, nor can you re-upload them to the internet, broadcast them by air, cable, or streaming services, alter them in any way, or use them in your own media content.
2. Your Public Display rights are limited to the License level you have purchased. For Basic – this is intended for small organizations and single offices that intend to play the Edited Files on up to three (3) screens at one (1) location or address. For Extended Licenses, you may play the Edited Files on up to fifteen (15) screens simultaneously at up to fifteen (15) locations or addresses. The Premium License is valid for up to one hundred (100) screens at up to one hundred (100) locations or addresses. If you need Licenses for more sites or more screens, or a broadcast license, please contact me directly at: tyler@discoveroregon.org
3. This License covers public displays of the Edited Content as associated with other commercial practices (IE doctors office waiting rooms, nursing homes). Screening of the films themselves cannot be the main focus of the commercial activity. You may not sell tickets to screenings, sell rentals, include on a streaming platform, or simply hold film screenings. 4. As long as these terms are met, there is no limit to the amount of time you can display these films – and they are yours to display in perpetuity at your organization or place of business.
5. Although all Licenses provided under this Agreement are administered by a single user, they may be copied and displayed across your organization to the limits described on your receipt and in this License agreement.

D. Other Legal Provisions.

1. This Agreement will be governed by the laws of the State of Oregon, excluding its body of law relating to conflicts of law and copyright law. If any provision of this Agreement is found invalid, the other provisions will not be affected. You must be of legal age to enter this Agreement.
2. Any claim or controversy arising out of the Agreement will be referred at the request of either Party to a Mediator. If the dispute is not settled first through Mediation, the Parties will be bound to enter into Arbitration in the city of Portland in the State of Oregon. Both Parties agree to be bound by the decision of the arbitrator.
